



On the Day

Timings

Mini/Junior competition: Saturday 9.15am-3pm

Adults competition: Saturday 4pm – 8.30pm

Youth competition: Sunday 9.15am-3.30pm

Doors will open to competitors and 1 chaperone (preferable the club representative) at 8.45am on Saturday and Sunday.

Spectators can enter at 9am both days.

Adults arrival time Saturday: 3.30pm, spectators at 3.45pm

You will be checked in by a member of staff at the front desk and shown where to go.

N.B: You do not need to arrive at the start if you are competing later, but please allow time in case we are running ahead. If you are not available when your category is called you will miss your slot to compete.




Awards

Equipment

Please ensure you have completed the music/bio/rigging form by 5th April 2026.

The below items will be provided by the competition:

Hoops: tabbed 75cm & 80cm, tabless 85cm/90cm/95cm

Silks: Firetoys youth brand, medium stretch. Prodigy adults brand, low stretch.

Please do not bring your own hoops.

You are welcome to bring your own equipment for silks & open categories.

Equipment must be rigged to a single point and will be on a swivel. We use a pulley system so you can set your desired height before your routine starts. Please ensure any kit you bring is clearly labelled. We will not accept any liability to loss or damage to any equipment you bring.

Equipment

There will be no run throughs on the day prior to your performance.

Crash mats:

It will be compulsory for all mini, junior and youth competitors to use a crash mat. The provided mat will be 2m x 1.2m and 20cm deep.


A reminder that props should be hand held only, no large items, and must not make a mess. No liquids or glitter etc. Any items not allowed will be turned away on the day.

Equipment

The rig we will be using is a juggle gear BIG RIG!

The rigging point is approx. 6m high, and will use a pulley system. The space between the legs is approx. 5sq meters. Please bear this in mind for your floorwork.

There will be space between the rig legs and the judges, so you can travel further forward. You will be allowed to see the set up very briefly once you have arrived, but no equipment run throughs will be available on the day.



Music

Please ensure you have completed the music/bio/rigging form by 5 th April 2026.

Music is to be no longer than 3mins and no expletives. Please bring a backup on the day on your phone or tablet just in case!

Facilities

There will be a tuckshop available, with snacks, hot and cold drinks. Cash and card is accepted.
